

## Elements of Horror

irony - using words to convey the meaning that is the opposite of its meaning

foreshadowing - writer gives an advance hint of what's to come later in the story.  
Lots of times at the beginning.  
\*hint of things to come or happen.

verbal  
difference between what is said and what is meant

irony - verbal words used in a way that their intended meaning is different from the actual meaning of the word.

situational - difference between what is actually happening or what is expected.

Suspense - excitement or worry that you feel when you are waiting to find out what happened or will happen.

mood - creates certain feelings or vibes in the reader through description or words.

Surprise - unusual or unexpected event.
